Reference is made to your letter of January 29, 1979, regarding a complaint concerning the election procedures employed by the Economic Action Committee of the Gulf Coast.

Questions in regard to that election for board representatives of the poor have also been raised to personnel of this office, prompting us to write a letter on January 12, 1979, to the Reverend Mr. L. R. James, who is Board Chairman of that agency. We addressed a number of concerns in our letter, including the question of sufficient notice of the election, which you expressed as your primary concern on behalf of your complainants.

In response to this particular issue, we received a copy of a letter provided by Radio Station KIOX in Bay City, Texas (enclosure #1), stating that the announcement for the election for board members ran on Station KIOX twice a day, December 12 through December 29, 1978, for a total of twenty-eight times. Additionally, we received a copy of a notice which appeared in the Palacios Beacon, Palacios, Texas, on December 14, 1978 (enclosure #2).

We agree that greater publicity and additional notice would have been desirable. This issue, along with others as indicated above, is being dealt with by our Regional Office personnel.

We appreciate your interest and concern, and assure you that we are working with the Economic Action Committee of the Gulf Coast to resolve the remaining issues. If we can provide further information or assistance, please do not hesitate to call on us.
