Your case has been referred to the Department of Justice for review and to determine if the Department of Justice will bring a civil action in Federal District Court based on your charge.

If the Department of Justice determines that it will bring a civil action, you have a right to intervene in such an action. If the Department of Justice determines that it will not bring a civil action based on your charge, you will be notified and receive a Notice of Right to Sue, which will entitle you to sue the respondent on your own behalf.
