This concerns Mrs. Octavio Saenz-Centeno, 2212 Joyce Corpus Christi, Tex., and her husband Dr. Octavio Saenz-Centeno. First, Mrs. Saenz is an American Citizen who got married to Dr. Octavio Saenz-Centeno, a Nicaraguan. She had to leave her husband who stayed in Nicaragua. She left because of her acute illness. Her husband who stayed in Nicaragua would normally have to wait 17 more months before he could come into the states.

What I would like you to please do is to help get a waiver so that her husband be admitted with a permanent visa. This is urgent because of the physical and mental condition of his wife who is bordering nervous exhaustion.

I'm enclosing first, a very favorable report from the American Consul in Nicaragua, Mr. Charles Rice. Secondly, a very urgent letter from DR. Hugh Kennedy, her personal physician, concerning Mrs. Saenz.
