I discovered recently that I never did acknowledge your nice letter complimenting me and encouraging me on my interest in restudying the assassination of President Kennedy.

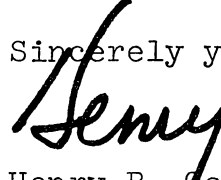

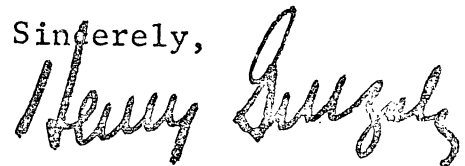
Please forgive my delay in responding to your letter enclosing a copy of a resolution introduced and adopted at the Mid-Year Conference of the American G I Forum in late February.
