In reply to your letter of May 11, 1963, Mrs. Aurora Sanchez, 104 Matamoros Street, Beeville, Texas, receives Aid to Families of Dependent children through our agency. The \$107.00 monthly grant she receives for her nine children is the maximum grant for Aid to Families of Dependent Children in the state of Texas.

Our County does not have surplus food commodities; however, Mrs. Sanchez has been assisted by the Salvation Army, County Welfare, Kiwanas Club and various other individuals and agencies. Mr. Robert Bell, local Service Officer, is processing her husband's application for VA compensation and he has assisted Mrs. Sanchez on numerous occasions. She was also referred to the local school authorities regarding the Free Lunch Program. Usually, Mrs. Sanchez is a step ahead of us in finding and using available resources.

The marital difficulties of Mr. and Mrs. Sanchez apparently stem from the incapacity of Mr. Sanchez. Perhaps future medical treatment and Vocational Rehabilitation will enable this family to be reunited. We would appreciate any assistance you could give us in counseling with Mrs. Sanchez toward this ultimate goal.

We appreciate your interest in Mrs. Sanchez and her problems and we can assure you that our agency will do everything possible to assist this family.
