In 1970 and 1972, Democrats in both state and congressional contests put up feisty battle despite the seemingly overwhelming colds against them. In 1974, one of those Democrats against finally specessful, Raul Castro (no relation to the Cuba Castros), born in Mexico, was a judge of Tueson in the fifties, Ambassador to Bolivia and El Salvador in the sixties, and Democrats nominates for Governor in 1970. He came surprisingly close to upsetting incombent Jack Williams a Republican who seemed unbeatable at the beginning of the campaign

Castro's 1970 race was a considerable feat, and he was the clear favorite for the Democratical nomination in 1974. No strident liberal, Castro had pointedly refused to support a recall drive and by Cesar Chavez's United Farm Workers against Governor Williams in 1972; when the UFW gas into trouble in California, it pulled totally out of Arizona, and the recall drive fizzled. It was, in other words, a good thing not to be associated with. Indeed, Castro's moderation was such that he could appeal to the so-called "pinto" Democrats, who still dominate the courthouses in the statement of Carl Hayden's.

But it was not the "pintos" who won for Castro in 1974, nor was it his fellows Mexican-Americans; only 19% of all Arizonaus have Spanish-speaking backgrounds, and most of them do not register and vote. What won for Castro was home town support in Tucson and the good will his early lead built up for him among the mass of white, middle-class voters. In fact Castro was lucky his early lead was so large, for the Republican nomines, Russell Williams (not relation to the incumbent), proved to be an attractive and aggressive candidate who nearly wondered.

Castro's victory symbolizes the end of an era, an era in which Arizona politics was dominated by Barry Goldwater and the men around him. Now the state is well into an era of political fluring when different kinds of candidates from different parties can all win elections. The Democrats' advantages, in contrast, are few: a feistiness and willingness to work hard, and in some cases environmental issues.
