You will recall that Dr. Garcia furnished you with certain additional facts pertaining to the general court-martial case of General Prisoner Rosendo G. Gonzales and you asked to be advised if it were possible to have a review made of the record of trial for the purpose of reducing the sentence of the prisoner, based upon the information furnished to you.

I have received a report from The Judge Advocate General, who has jurisdiction in matters of this nature, with respect to the case of General Prisoner Gonzales. I have taken the liberty of inclosing a copy of that report for your information.

Your interest in the case of General Prisoner Gonzales is appreciated, and I trust the information I have furnished will be helpful to you in replying to the inquiry you received.
