Dear Dr. Garcia:

In reference to Mrs Lucille M. Guzman's letter dated February 16, 1984, I have inquired about Mr. Alex Guzman's efforts to obtain employment at the Corpus Christi Army Depot.

Mr. Guzman was one of the Air Traffic Controllers employed by the Federal Aviation Agency who went on strike and was dismissed by Executive Order. He is being considered for employment at the Corpus Christi Army Depot for the position of "Electronic Measurement Standard and Calibration Mechanic, WG-11"; however, clearance through the "Investigative Branch" of the Office of Personnel Management in Washington, D.C. is required before Mr. Guzman can be hired.

Since the position for which Mr. Guzman is being considered is "sensitive" it may take longer for the Depot to receive a clearance than from a "non-senitive" position.

Mrs Connie Nelson, a staffing specialist in the Recruitment and Placement Branch of the Civilian Personnnel Office recently met with Mr. Guzman and discussed the above matter. Her phone number for information purposes is (512) 939-4359.
