As we discussed, I have responded to the request of Dr. Hector Garcia to attempt to locate signed original material from various dignitaries which he believes were picked up from his office by CCSU representatives about three months ago.

There do not appear to be any signed original letters from John F. Kennedy or Robert Kennedy, although numerous copies are in the files. However, there are several by Lyndon Johnson and two by Ted Kennedy. Others are by Ralph Yarborough, Lloyd Bentsen, Henry B. Gonzalez, J. Edgar Hoover, Walter Mondale, Sargent Shriver, Solomon Ortiz, J. Stanley Pottinger of the Department of Justice, Congressman John Young, Tom Walter, Joseph Montoya, Francisco Cuevas Cancino of the Mexican Mission to the U. N., and White House Assistants Clifford Alexander, Marvin Watson, Lee White and David North.

These are found in the six boxes marked "Garcia office, personal letters" and in the one marked "Personalities." These were the only ones in which I conducted an extensive search, since Dr. Garcia's remarks led me to believe that these would be the ones where they would be located.

I should also add that, in the six boxes from his personal office, there is a large quantity of material of a rather personal nature, as well as many files concerning his family.

I thought that you would like to call Dr. Garcia to tell him what has been located. He indicated that he would like to come down here if we find them. If he feels that there are others than those listed above, I would be happy to look some more.

Dear Dr. Garcia:

I want you to see a copy of Eugenia Landes' report on the results of her search for signed original materials that may have been picked up about 3 months ago.
