

ESCUELA DE PARITA SE INAUGURO HOY

Durante el dfa de hoy se inaugurará la escuela primaria de Parita, Prov. de Herrera. Estaban presentes en la ceremonia el Prof. Rigoberto Paredes, Ministro de Educación y otros altos personajes del Gobierno Nacional, así como también el Sr. Vicente Ximenes, segundo encargado de la Misión Económica de los EE. UU. y su señora; el Sr. Milton Eshleman, Contralor del USAID en Panamá y su señora.

La escuela primaria de Parita fue construida mediante el programa de construcción de escuelas nacionales bajo contrato a un costo de B/. 120.000 aportados por el Gobierno de los EE. UU. La firma constructora, Mezcla, S.A. inició la construcción en septiembre de 1964 y terminó en junio de 1965. La escuela posee 15 aulas de clases con capacidad para 450 estudiantes, tiene un aula para economía doméstica, un salón para maestros, un salón de artes industriales, una oficina para la dirección y una biblioteca.
