Dear Mr. Saenz:

Your claim for non-service connected pension has been given consideration upon receipt of a report of treatment at Brooke Army Hospital from December 4, 1950, to December 23, 1950.

Based upon the above-mentioned report it has been determined that your disability diagnosed as removal of gall bladder with mild symptoms is not permanently and totally disabling. Your claim for non-service-connected pension therefore is disallowed.

In order that your claim may be reopened it will be necessary for you to submit medical evidence of your physical condition which shows a probable permanent and total disability, a report of your employment status and earnings. It will also be necessary for you to comply with any request by the Veterans Administration for a medical examination to be made of you by the Veterans Administration at such time. A form for an employment statement is enclosed for your convenience.
