Dear Senator Johnson:

Further reference is made to your interest in the application for a review of his discharge executed by Mr. Adolfo DeJesus Reyna, Veterans Administration Hospital, Waco, Texas.

The Army Discharge Review Board has reviewed the facts connected with Mr. Reyna's discharge from the service and has concluded that he is entitled to an honorable discharge under the provisions of Army Regulations 615-365, convenience of the government and Special Regulation 600-450-10 for medical disqualification existing prior to induction and not aggravated by military service. Accordingly, the Secretary of the Army has directed that an honorable discharge certificate be issued to him with the reason and authority for separation shown as Section 301, Public Law 346, 78th Congress, approved 22 June 1944, Army Regulation 615-365 and Special Regulation 600-450-10.

Mr. Reyna has been notified of the decision of the Secretary of the Army and has been requested to forward to this office his original discharge certificate, report of separation and/or other official statement regarding his discharge previously issued to him. Upon receipt of such documents from him, attention will be given to the issuance of the honorable discharge certificate to him.

Mr. Reyna was advised of your interest in his behalf.
