Dear Sir:

I received the package containing the agency's reply to my charge of "discrimination", package that was received by me on Monday, July 30, 1979, plus the correspondence or material submitted by your office with the agency's enclosures.

I am returning form containing the name of Mr. Reynundo Fuentes whom I am requesting be my representative in my appeal. Mr. Fuentes is an employee at the Corpus Christi Army Depot.

I am also in receipt of your certified letter informing me of the time and place of the hearing concerning my appeal.

I am therefore requesting answers to the questions below;

- a. Why is the hearing being held in Dallas, Texas instead of being held in Corpus Christi, Texas ?
- b. Who made the decision ?
- c. Why were not the rest of my allegations concerning my "discrimination" complaint not investigated by the EEO Office at the Corpus Christi Army Depot ?

- d. Did you question the agency's "fairness" or their failure to investigate all my allegations and charges concerning my "discrimination" complaint ?
- e. How are arrangements to be made regarding the presence of myself and witnesses at the hearing ?
- f. Who is going to "foot" the bill ??
- g. In my appeal concerning my "illegal and "wrongful" action by the Corpus Christi Army Depot, I have alleged that the "discrimination" against me because of national origin has been a continuous one on the part of the depot. My question is this; will your office be in a position to question the agency's failure to investigate the above charges I mentioned in my appeal ?
- Will my allegations be independently investigated by your office ??
- h. Why haven't I been furnished with a copy of applicable regulations as applied to the action against me ?

I need copies of regulations concerning s/l, lwop, requests for extended leave because of illnesses.

Copies of EEO regulations, amendments, the law, compensations laws, regulations, agency regulations, or CSC dealing with agency's rights to remove employees on extended leave because of illness or "off" compensation pay.

Copies of regulations as applicable to the "industrial" medical officer of a federal establishment.

Copies of regulations concerning removal actions by an agency, local regulations as well as CSC.

Copies of the new law as applicable to U.S. federal employees under the Merit Protection System.

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It is very imperative that I have copies of these and all other regulations dealing with the action taken against me by the managerial personnel at the Corpus Christi Army Depot, otherwise I will be unable to properly defend myself. I said before and I will say it again, copies of existing regulations have always been provided in the past upon request by anyone individual.

Unless I am in receipt of the above mentioned regulations I have to request to your office, because I will be unable to defend myself, that the hearing be cancelled until such a time that I am well prepared to do so.
