On November 28, 1983, City Ordinance Number 17742 went into effect. Section 3, subsection (a) refers to excessive false alarms and states, in part:

The City of Corpus Christi will assess a service fee of \$30.00 to the permit holder for each response by the City to notification of activation of an alarm system which is determined to be a false alarm in excess of eight (8) false alarms within a twelve (12) month period.

Our reports indicate that on the dates and times listed below, your alarm system exceeded the limit of eight (8) false alarms within a continuous twelve (12) month period:

The responding officer, finding no acceptable cause for an alarm to have been issued, recorded the complaints as false alarms.

Pursuant to the City Ordinance, you are hereby assessed a \$60.00 service fee payable to the City of Corpus Christi. The fee may be mailed to the Corpus Christi Police Department, Alarm Records, P. O. Box 9016, Corpus Christi, Texas 78469.

Failure to make this payment within ten (10) working days of receipt of this notice will result in the revocation of your alarm system permit. If you have any questions regarding this notice, please call the Corpus Christi Police Department, Alarm Records Clerk, at 886-2745.
