Dear Dr. Garcia:

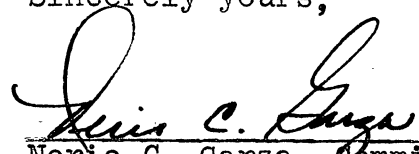
May I take this opportunity to wish you and your family a successful and Happy New Year.
