This is in reference to the communication from Mr. Xico P. Garcia, a medical student at the National University of Mexico in Mexico City, who would like to transfer to the University of Texas in order to complete his medical education.

As you know, the Office of Education does not recommend the acceptance or nonacceptance of students in any U.S. colleges and universities. Such determination must be made by appropriate officials of these institutions. However, this Office, upon request, does make interpretations of relative equivalence of foreign academic credentials. Should the Dean of the University of Texas Medical School desire such service, we will be happy to comply with his request.
