We have requested that the local boards consider Mexican Americans for the two vacancies in San Antonio and Temple. We have no vacancies in Van Horn. We have a Mexican American on the board in El Paso. We have requested Galveston, and Seguin to obtain a Mexican American. There is a Mexican American on the board at Lochart and Laredo. We have no vacancy on the board at Port Arthur. We requested the local board to obtain a Mexican American at Lubbock, Austin and Victoria. There is no vacancy at Wichita Falls.

I hope that we will be successful in endeavoring to increase the Mexican American membership on our boards. Thank you for bringing this matter to my attention.
