THE TEXAS DECLARATION AND THE EDUCATION.

MARCH 2, 1836 WASHINGTON ON THE BRAZOS " IT HAS FAILED TO ESTABLISH ANY PUBLIC SYSTEM OF EDUCATION, ALTHOUGH PROSSESSED OF ALLMOST BOUNDLESS RESOURDES (THE PUBLIC DOMAIN), AND ALTHOUGH, IT IS AN AXION, IN POLITICAL SCIENCE THAT UNLESS A PEOPLE ARE EDUCATED AND ENLIGHTENED IT IS IDLE TO EXPECT THE CONTINUANCE OF CIVIL LIBERTY, OR THE CAPACITY FOR SELF GOVERNMENT."

IMMEDIATELY AFTER THAT THE "TEXAS SYSTEM OF EDUCATION" SEPARATE AND FOREVER UNEQUALED STARTED IN THE STATE OF TEXAS."
