As we continue to develop our academic program, it is important that naval science continue at Roy Miller High School. I applied for a unit and have not received acknowledgement from the Navy.

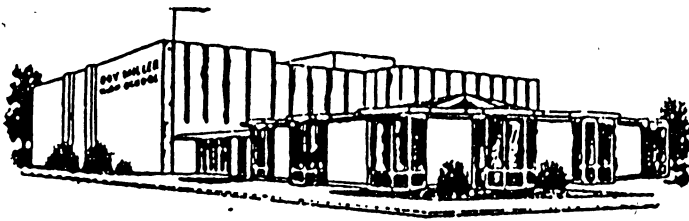
We are pre-registering students for the upcoming school year, thus a quick response is appreciated to meet deadlines on course offering transfers.
