Dear Dr. Garcia:

This refers to your note dated 5 October 1972 regarding Mr. Jose L. Garcia, 3529 Bobolink, Corpus Christi, Texas.

On 6 October 1972, I met with Mr. Garcia and discussed his opportunities for Civil Service employment. Since Mr. Garcia does not have Civil Service status, it will be necessary for him to obtain eligibility on an appropriate Commission register. Mrs. Norma San Miguel, a member of my staff, explained the procedures for obtaining eligibility on the appropriate registers in order that his name could be referred to this Center for employment consideration.

At the present time, however, the opportunities for employment are not very favorable, as the Civil Service registers which are currently open are not appropriate to Mr. Garcia's experience and qualifications. It was strongly recommended that he check frequently with the Civil Service Commission in Corpus Christi for announcements which are compatible to his experience.

Your interest in referring Mr. Garcia is appreciated. Please be assured that at such time as Mr. Garcia establishes eligibility and his name is referred by the Civil Service Commission, he will be considered for our position vacancies, along with the other qualified candidates.
