Dear Sir:

As a loyal Democrat of Kosciusko, Texas, I wish to register a protest against the recent temporary appointment of
Rutherford for the United States Post Office in Kosciusko, Texas.

It is well known that the person appointed did not support
the fundamental principles of the Democratic Party in 1956-
1957 and 1960. He has openly admitted this when questioned
about it. While there is no question concerning the integrity
of the person receiving this appointment, there is a question
of immediate importance concerning the political course
encountered when our Democratic Party, funds received by
you, fail to hold up to the expected standard. It is fully
understood by Democratic voters that persons elected to office
on the Democratic ticket will hold to their specific duties
as born of the Democrats, which includes the making of sound
policies along every line.

We who stand by our policies in the bitter battles of 1956-
1960 feel that this appointment should go to someone with a record
of proven loyalty to the Democratic Party.

I feel that the replacement is one of personal political
expediency and will not validly serve the best interest of
the people. It is strongly suggested that action be taken
immediately to remedy this situation and settle the extreme
political unrest now existing in the Democratic Party in this
area.
