Dear Citizen Advisory Committee Member:

As you know, with the assistance of the local advisory committees, the Constitutional Revision Commission has completed the first part of its The product of that effort, a proposed new constitution for Texas, is presently being printed and is expected to be available for distribution shortly after the first of November 1973.

The presentation of the proposed new Constitution fulfills a portion of the Commission's responsibilities. However, it is also charged by law with insuring maximum public participation, disseminating information on its findings and recommendations, and making its report widely available the citizens of Texas. Toward these ends, Commission is planning a series of public meetings across the State during November in order to meet with the advisory committee members, general public and State legislators. The purpose of these meetings will be to explain in some detail the major proposals contained in the Commission recommendations and to answer questions concerning those proposals.

The meeting for your area has been scheduled for Monday, November 12, from 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. in the Exposition Hall at the Corpus Christi Convention Center. I hope you will make every effort to be present.
