Enclosed is a letter from the Internal Revenue Service. On a previous date the G. I. Forum had been notified that we were exempt from income tax and that contributions made to the organization were deductible. Now comes this letter which says that we are not. Please consider the following action:

- 1) An appeal
- 2) An amendment to the constitution for the purpose of qualifying as a war veterans' organization or a non-profit organization qualifying to be exempt for purposes of donations.
