I like to request a couple of Hundred of them to help us use in the reorganizing of the Forum Here in Ohio. There is critical need to reorganized, because of the many problems that are now evident, in the programs of the War on Poverty, Community Action groups, ect, ect,.

Just a couple of weeks ago we ran into some problems with a Radio Station WPRO, Fremont, Ohio. The owner of the station denied Mr. Eddie Cruz, and Billy Reyna the sale of time to broadcast the Spanish language programs that this two individuals were presenting to the Hispanic community of Ohio, Michigan, and Indiana. So as you can see its deeper than that. Mr. Wolf stated that the FCC. rules against Foreign language broadcasts, and that the FCC is already cracking down on all radio stations who have foreign language programs, in the big cities, and in the border states. How much thruth is in all this no one really knows. If you have information on this matter kindly inform me so that I can inturn referr same to Mr. Cruz, and Mr. Reyna. This programs have been on the air for more than 12 years.
