Dear Dr. Garcia:


We have enclosed three items which may be of interest:

1. A copy of the White House announcement of the appointment of Armando Rodriguez as coordinator of the New Mexican American Affairs Unit of the U. S. Office of Education.
2. A fact sheet on OEO's programs for migrant farm workers.
3. An item which appeared in yesterday's Federal Register, calling for a change in the regulations governing "Green Card" commuters. The proposed regulations would bar these commuters from taking jobs with employers engaged in a labor dispute, but would not prevent the employer's old employees (who are commuters) from continuing to work.

Those interested in commenting on this proposed regulation should do so in writing; comments should be in the hands of the Immigration Service by May 28.
