
Dear Dr. Hector:

Dear Congressman Young:

I am replying to your letter of May 9 concerning your interest, on behalf of Dr. Hector P. Garcia, in the immigrant visa registrations of Mr. Mauricio LEAL Alaniz and his son, Jesus LEAL Alaniz.

Despite a thorough check of our files, we are unable to locate any record of an immigrant visa registration for Mr. Leal and his son. It could be that Mr. Leal and his son are in the process of registering for immigration to the United States and that the necessary forms have not yet reached us. Another possibility is that Mr. Leal has simply written to us for information. We do not maintain records of correspondence unless there is an immigrant visa registration.

If Dr. Garcia knows of any forms or letters in the possession of Mr. Leal which would indicate that he is registered at this Consulate General for an immigrant visa, we would be pleased to make another file search. In that event, it would be helpful to have the dates and places of birth for both Mr. Leal and his son. Their current address would also be of assistance.

It has been a pleasure to give you this information. Please write to me whenever we may provide you with information or otherwise be of assistance to you.
