Our contention is that conditions and wages provided to these workers is not only below the requirements set forth by law, but to a large degree are below any conditions suitable to the human dignity of man. Do you believe that the type of lodging and board offered by the farmers is an incentive to an individual who although may not be qualified for other work still desires to live as a human being and as a first-class citizen? We concur with the conditions as stated by Secretary of Labor, Mr. Wertz. We therefore urge your support for his proposed benefits for this type of labor.
