The Mexican Chamber of Commerce:

1. Mr. Arnold Medine, ATTORNEY-at-Law- He discussed the Nueces County Bar ASSN., a lawyer referraz service. We merely informed the public to call 883-3971 if they need a lawyer and don't have money. We also informed them this service advises if a lawyer's fee is reasonable. We discussed this topic mainly for public information. For those people who don't know this service is available.
2. DR. Hector P. Garcia -
 - (a.) In discussion of the Nueces County Medical Society Memorial Hospital. call 884-5442. This professional organization is available to visitors or tourists as well as to people here in case of an emergency; and they don't have a physician. However the public was informed that there is a charge. Arrangements are made to pay the bill.
 - (b.) Also DR. Garcia advised the people to co-operte with the School Board. That they were doing a good job etc.
 - (c.) DR. Garcia Also discussed that Mexican Chamber of Commerce, GI Forum, and Lulac organizations help the people in many ways. for instance in their education by awarding scholarships.
